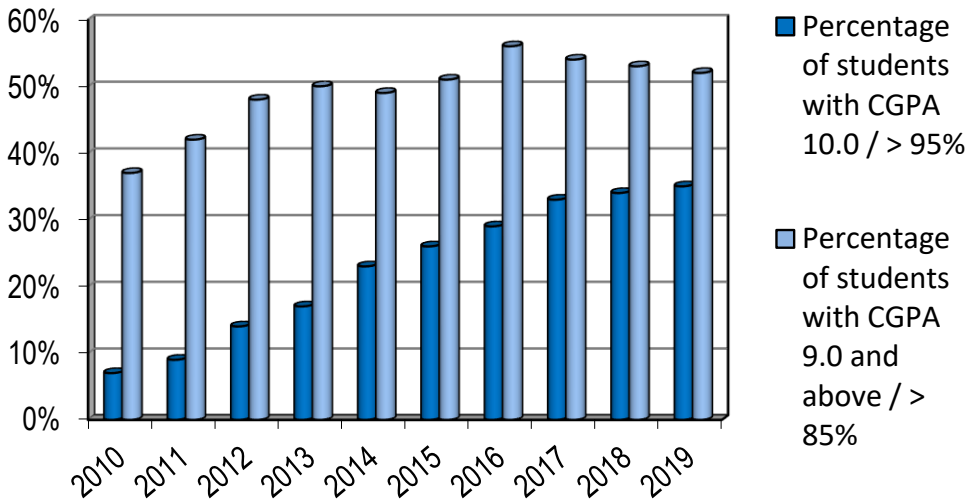

Aims

The aims of KT are-

- ◆ Topay personal attention to all the students
- ◆ To develop concepts to enable the students to solve problems
- ◆ To conduct tests to assess the knowledge and skill levels of the students
- ◆ To guide/counsel the students

In order to ensure personal attention, batches will be limited to 30 students.

Eligibility

Students enrolled in private and government schools in the respective classes are eligible for admission. The details about current enrollment must be provided in the prescribed form.

Admission Procedure

Students seeking admission must apply in the prescribed form. The form is available and can be obtained from the office or can be downloaded and printed directly from our website <http://tutorials.kushbiz.com>. Admission is granted on FCFS (First Come, First Served) basis.

Fees are payable on annual / instalment basis in advance. Fees will be payable by cash only. The payment must be received before the start of the session or instalment period otherwise student will not be allowed to attend the classes.

The number of sessions for normal class will be 6 per week from classes 8 to 10 and 3 per week for classes 11 and 12. This is subject to change. Any change shall be intimated to the students and the same shall be binding without any exception.

Class Timings

*Normally, classes will be held from Monday through Saturday during evenings. **Special batches for all classes will also be held during morning hours for students who cannot attend during evening hours.***

Classes will not be held on the days declared as holidays under the Negotiable Instruments Act. There may be exceptions to this in case there is urgent need to meet the requirements of a course or the needs of students.
